Art Van Elslander Gift to Create Endowed Chair of Cardiovascular Services at Providence

Warren – A donation by the A.A. Van Elslander Foundation will support the creation of an endowment called the Shukri W. David, M.D. Art Van Elslander Endowed Chair for Cardiovascular Services for Providence Hospitals. The amount of the donation will not be disclosed. The endowment gift came through the St. John Providence Foundations, which coordinates fundraising for St. John Providence, its hospitals, entities and programs.

Annual interest income from the endowment will be used to advance cardiovascular services at Providence-Providence Park Hospital in Southfield and Novi. Under the leadership of the endowed chair, funds will be used to invest in programs, facilities, equipment, research, staff recruitment and retention.

"It is truly rare to encounter a physician the caliber of Dr. Shukri David. His talent, compassion and commitment are without equal, and I am honored to call him not only my doctor, but also one of my closest friends. I can think of no one more deserving of this legacy than Dr. David," says Mr. Van Elslander.

"I feel very fortunate to have a friend as caring and compassionate as Mr. Van Elslander," says Dr. David. "His generosity has had a positive and lasting impact on our health system and our community. Creating this endowment will strengthen our position as one of the leading providers of heart and vascular care in Michigan."

Dr. David is the chief of cardiology at Providence and the system chair of the Heart and Vascular Center of Excellence for St. John Providence.

A donation to the St. John Hospital & Medical Center expansion campaign helped build the Van Elslander Pavilion patient tower, which added 144 private patient rooms, a new Heart & Circulatory Center and Diagnostic Imaging Center. Those gifts have also led to the creation of the Van Elslander Neuroscience Center of Excellence at St. John Providence; the Van Elslander Surgical Innovation Center, located at Providence-Providence Park Hospital, Novi; the Van Elslander Cancer Center at SJH&MC and the Mary Ann Van Elslander Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and Special Care Nursery at SJH&MC.
